This ranged from:

- A new metro station in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia;
- A new water main interconnector in Cork City to link two sides of the city together to ensure drinking water can be diverted from one side of the city to the other in the event of a main break;
- The conversion & redevelopment of a 35 million pound apartment complex in London City Centre.

Approximately 80 students benefited from this experience. After the event the graduates took the time out to answer any questions the students had on a one-to-one basis.

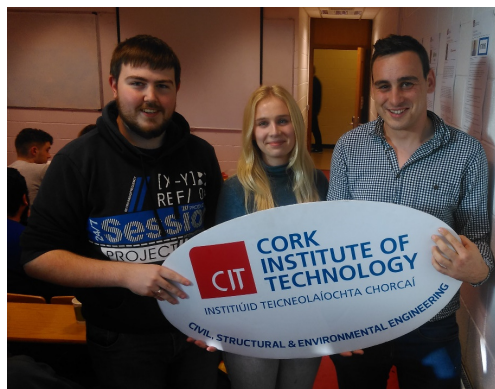
