PROFILE

OBJECTIVE OF PROJECT

To provide an informal opportunity for all students to meet and start to get know others from all stages of the programme as well as the postgrads and staff team. Name tags were distributed and the students actively encouraged to talk to people that they didn't know.

DESCRIPTION

A coffee morning was held in the West Atrium for all the current students, postgrads, local alumni and staff of the B.Eng. (Hons) in Sustainable Energy Engineering Degree. A pop-up quiz took place encouraging the students to work together to answer the question and win the prize goody bags supplied by the Transition to CIT team.

All students were invited/ taken to the event as part of a lecture period. All staff course team was invited including course board members, service lecturers from other departments and support staff.





IMPACT & OUTCOMES

BENEFITS

- There was a great buzz around the event as the groups hadn't realised how many students were on the course. Roughly 20 per year over 4 years, we estimate attendance in excess of 60 on the day.
- Students noticed people who they already knew from elsewhere (home, society, club) but that they didn't know were on the same course.
- A stronger sense of the group identity was promoted.
- Three students won a goody bag!!

IMPACT ON STUDENTS

It is difficult to put an exact figure on how many students were positively impacted but it was ~180 students at the very least (all of our 1st years).
